

## **Phylogenetic tree**



This phylogenetic tree illustrates the occurrence of the SNPs identified so far amongst descendants of the Stewarts from around the early 14<sup>th</sup> century.

As a result of testing a documented descendant of Robert III and a descendant of his halfbrother Sir John Stewart, Sheriff of Bute, it is now known that many, if not all, of the descendants of these two brothers carry the SNP ZZ52 (Robert III's line) or the SNP Y14197 (Bute Stewarts). It is not yet known in which generation these SNPs occurred, but Y14198 appeared in a later generation than Y14197.

SNPs Z17581, Z17582 and A8343 have not been allocated to one or more specific lines of descent, but could all be linked to only one of Robert II's sons.
